When presenting *Oncostele* Robert Winkley 'Solar Place', he mentioned in it background some *Odontoglossum victoriense*, that I do not sure if I listened it correctly but looking the parentage on Orchid Pro there is not such parent. My observation if that parent imparts the upright inflorescence why need to be stake, as showing in the picture? I think is not stake it may does not look pleasing cascade.

About what may acceptable while judging presentation, showing pictures and example of the opposite, what is not acceptable should be also beneficial.

Rather than presented individuals' examples of what would expect of a cross regarding the type and breeding, summarizing these characteristics in a chart or table mentioning the species or grex would be more didactic.
