Brassia Punkin Parfait 'Timberlane' HCC/AOS (79 points) Brassia Spider's Gold x Brassia aurantiaca

Twenty-four crowd flowers on two inflorescences; dorsal sepal curve; sepals and petals orange-gold, centrally spotted burgundy; lip yellow-gold centrally spotted faded burgundy; substance medium; texture matte

Brassia verrucosa 'Santa Barbara' AM/AOS (80 points)
Eight flowers on one inflorescence; flowers apple green color, spotted wart black proximally; lip twisted yellow, dotted black centrally; substance medium; texture crystalline.

## Brassia Lance 'Jeannette' AM/AOS (87 points)

 Brassia caudata x Brassia gireoudianaSeventeen larges, well presented flowers on one aubergine color inflorescence; dorsal sepal curve, flowers, pale chartreuse, deeper coloration proximally, fading to amber distally; blotched deep red-brown proximal portions on all segments, smaller in size on petals and lip; substance medium; texture matte.

Brassidium Shooting Star 'Stardust' HCC/AOS 76 points
Brsdm. Gilded Urchin x Brs. Edvah Loo
Fourteen evenly spaced flowers beautifully presented in two planes on one gracefully arched inflorescence; sepals and petals apple green, spotted oxblood, proximally, two third; lateral sepals slightly twisted; lip white, blushed pale green, spotted oxblood basally, callus golden yellow; column and anther cap soft green; substance firm; texture satiny, lip sparkling.

## Bratonia Shelob 'Tolkien-Peloric' Bratonia Olmec x Brassia Edvah Loo

Twelve peloric flowers on two inflorescences; sepals green, suffuse purple; peloric petals spotted black purple, basally half; lip lighter mauve spotted black purple; substance firm; texture crystalline.
