## **Genus Ida**

According to the geography distribution *Lycaste* can be divide in two location: the species located in South America, formerly known as Sudamerlycaste and the ones distributed in Mesoamerican. According to the Plants of the World Online database of the Royal Horticulture Society. Sudamerlycaste is considered a synonym of *Ida*.

Angela Ryan and some colleagues at the Royal Botanic Gardens carried out molecular analyses finding that South American species of *Lycaste* section Fimbriate Fowlie formed a group more closely related to *Anguloa* than to *Lycaste* itself.

Ryan and Henry Oakeley published the genus name Ida in 2003 leaving Lycaste to a group of species mainly Mesoamerican in distribution. (Pupulin and Karremans 2017).
