Descriptions



Pleurothallis marthae 'Juan Carlos Uribe' AM/AOS 83 Points

Fifteen flowers and nine buds on 13 inflorescences borne on a very well-grown plant; dorsal sepal and petals chartreuse, dark green veined; fused lateral sepal chartreuse, brown overlaid; lip chartreuse, brown rose overlaid, darker brown rose centrally; substance firm; texture crystalline; commended for unusual color form.

Pleurothallis teaguei 'Alba Connor' CCE/AOS (92 points)

Two hundred twenty-five flowers and 23 buds on 19 short inflorescences borne from the leaf axils of large elongated dark green cordate leaves; sepals mahoganyblack; rolled petals creamy yellow; lip creamy yellow, basally blotched mahogany; column abbreviated, creamy yellow; substance soft; texture matte.

Barbosella cogniauxi 'Little Fingers' CCE/AOS (92 points)

Three hundred striking yellow-green flowers lavender apically and 30 buds on 330 inflorescences well displayed 360 degrees on a tree fern slab; plant including inflorescences measuring 19 cm by 23 cm; awarded as *Barbosella porschii*, now recognized as *Barbosella cogniauxiana* (Sept 2020).

Trisetella andreettae 'Marion' CBR/AOS (0 points)

Two flowers and five buds on one 4-cm inflorescence; flower chartreuse overlaid redbrown; fused lateral sepals dark mahogany red; petals inconspicuous; hinged lip oxblood red; caudae chartreuse; recognized for unique boat shape 2-cm flowers.

Barbosella dolichorhiza 'Greenbeard' CBR/AOS

Six flowers and four buds borne individually on 8-cm upright inflorescences;, plant measure 11 cm wide by 10 cm tall; leaves semi-terete, 4 cm wide by 5 cm long; flowers golden yellow, centrally translucent pale green; lateral sepals touching, centrally transparent green line; lip maroon, apple green apically; column apple green, anther cap mahogany; substance firm; texture satiny.
