Phalaenopsis mirabilis (Seidenf.) Schuit. 2007 Subgenus Parishinae Section Deliciosae Species Data Sheet

The common name for Phalaenopsis mirabilis is The Wonderful Phalaenopsis. The flower is only found in Thailand growing beside rivers in primary forests at elevations of 680 to 1300 meters. A small sized plant and flower (.28") {7 cm} Mirabilis is a warm to cool growing epiphyte that blooms in the fall on a pendant 8 to 10 cm. long. Only a few flowers per inflorescence. To this date, there are no primary hybrids registered using Phalaenopsis mirabilis.

Culture:

Phalaenopsis mirabilis is best grown hanging in baskets or mounted. It requires shade and warm temperatures. Frequent watering is required if hanging. Growing media must be well drained such as tree fern fibers; course fir bark or sphagnum moss.
