General Information:

Paphiopedilum glanduliferum has never been collected since its original description, so no further information is available regarding the habitat or location of the species.

General Description:

This species is known only from the type material and the description and illustration in Blume's *Rumphia* and there is wide disagreement about its correct classification. Blume's description is highly detailed; however, it causes confusion

because there are no plants available which fit the description he wrote. Often, this species has been linked with *Paphiopedilum praestans*, but differences in the staminode shield have caused disagreement as to which species is which.

OrchidWiz described this species as follows: This is a medium sized, terrestrial, and rarely epiphytic species with 4 to 6, narrowly linear-oblong, somewhat fleshy, rounded and tridenticulte at the apex, clear green, glabrous leaves found in New Guinea from sea level to 1700 meters.

Awards:


This species has been awarded by the AOS 40 times over the period 1968 through 2017 (AM-24; HCC-11; JC-2; CBM-1; CCM-1; CHM-1).

Hybrids:

Paphiopedilum glanduliferum has 96 First Generation offspring, and Total Progeny of 295 (through the 4th generation). This species has also been involved in creating Primary Hybrids 46 times as both the seed and pollen parent.

Paphiopedilum Susan Booth was registered in 1983 by F. Booth and is a cross of *Paph. rothschildianum x Paph. glanduliferum*. The hybrid has 88 First Generation offspring, and 126 total progeny. The hybrid has been awarded by AOS 106 times (FCC-1; AM-47; HCC-39; CCE-2; CCM-12).
