White Complex Paphiopedilums

Carol Klonowski has been growing orchids since the 1980's when a friend in Berkeley, gave her a cattleya and it bloomed with three big, dark lavender flowers and an intoxicating fragrance.

She built an entire greenhouse in her backyard to accomodate the precious plant, which only led her to buy more orchids. Then another friend gave her a membership to the Orchid Society of California and it's been a serious hobby and passion ever since.

Her talk on White Complex Paphiopedilums stems from a fascination with the nearly century-old breeding effort that produces these elegant, large, long-lasting blooms on

plants that carry the genetic material of up to seven species of paphs. She will discuss the history of complex paphs in general, then focus on the effort to create bigger and better white complexes for the past several decades, and the reasons why white complex paphs should be a part of every orchid lover's collection.

Carol has served as Director, Vice President, President and Past President of the Orchid Society of California for most of the past two decades, and currently is an accredited judge, Probationary, with the American Orchid Society, California Sierra Nevada Judging Center.
