# Orchids of the Dominican Republic

Our own, Manuel Aybar is originally from the Dominican Republic (a grower's paradise, as he describes it). He will be speaking on Orchid Species of the Dominican Republic. He has been growing orchids for more than 25 years. The genus that got him started was Dendrobium in which he specializes (phalaenopsistype).

He has been a member of the American Orchid Society since 1997 and the Greater North Texas **Orchid Society since** 2000. Manuel Aybar is an Accredited Judge of the American Orchid Society Judging program. His current research includes the orchids of the Dominican Republic, for which he has gone on numerous orchid collecting trips back to his home country. He has been extensively involved in the judging of many



shows around the US, including the Miami International Orchid Show, Redlands Show, Pacific Orchid Exhibition, and most of the southwest region (SWROGA) shows. He has also served as an international judge for Orchid Shows in Taiwan, Peru, Costa Rica, Colombia, as well as the World Orchid Conference (WOC) in Singapore, WOC South Africa.

He is affiliated with the Southwest Regional Orchid Growers Association (SWROGA), and within this association he serves on the Publications Committee and as the Webmaster for the organization's web site. He has given several orchid seminars throughout the area. He is a regular lecturer for the local orchid societies and visiting speaker for societies around the country.
